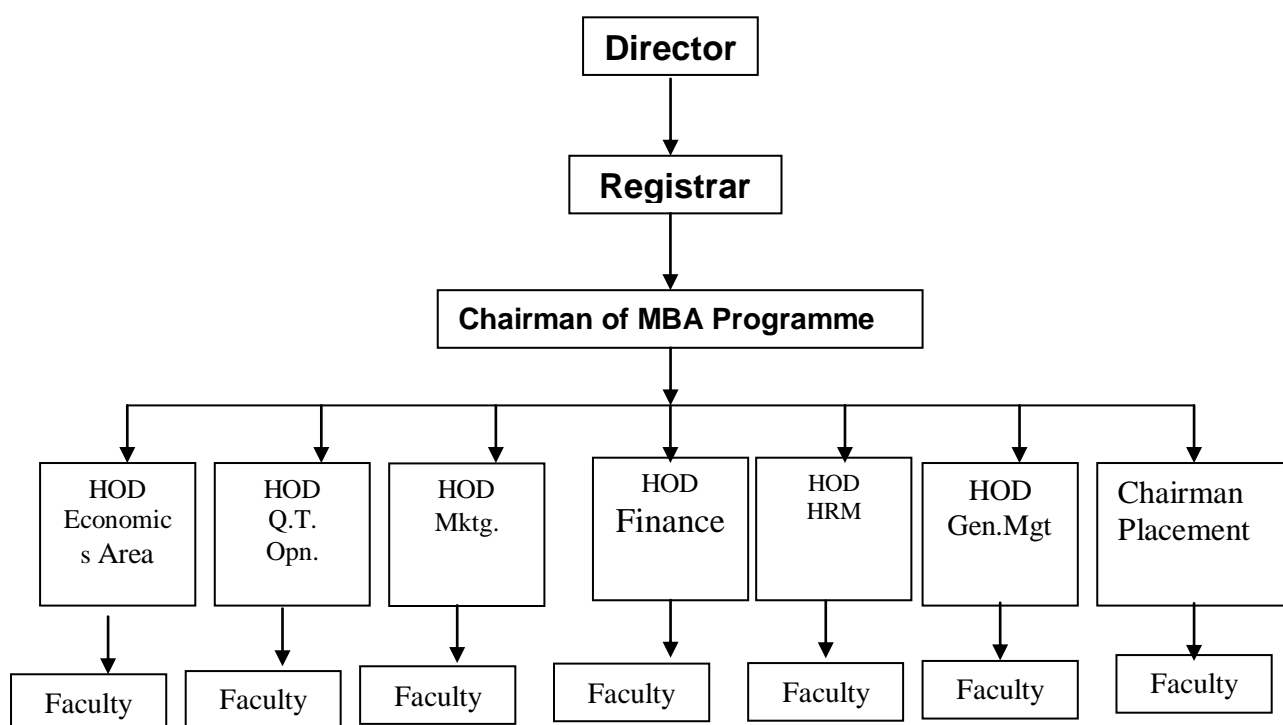

1. Nature and Extent of Involvement of faculty and students in academic affairs / improvements.

The academic calendar for next academic year is discussed in the faculty meeting in the month of March of the preceding year. The academic calendar approved by the faculty is sent for the approval of Academic Council and Governing Council to be held in March / April every year. The Academic Calendar gives information in respect of dates of admission, Commencement of Classes, Examinations, Vacations and Holidays etc.

The teachers/ instructors prepare their teaching plans for the various trimesters taking into consideration the academic calendar approved by Academic Council and the syllabus of the courses. The teaching plan is prepared by teachers in such a way that the class room teaching, assignments, quizzes, case studies, field trips and other students activities are completed well before the commencement of trimester examination.

The Controller of examinations as per the academic calendar conducts the examinations. A detailed plan of paper setting, faculty class room supervisions, overall senior supervision by senior supervisor, the duty of evaluation of answer books (double evaluation) is prepared by the Controller of Examination as per the direction of Examination Committee. The Objectivity is maintained and no laches is allowed in the examination system. The SIBER examination system has been appreciated by the various committees, which have visited the Institute since 1995. It is an ideal system to be followed by potential autonomous colleges.

The top management follows a transparent, open, democratic style of management. Each Head of Department and faculty in the department are delegated the powers as far as teaching, evaluation of the students is concerned. The faculty of each department openly discuss and

interact in respect of strengths and weaknesses of a particular course and suggest improvement. The faculty members are free to order any book they like which is useful to the students and faculty. As far as research consultancy and UGC, AICTE Projects are concerned there is complete decentralization. The administrative support is given by the office of the Institute to the faculty members and Heads of Departments. The internal credit is finalized by concerned faculty members and before finalization it is discussed in the faculty meeting. The Head of Department has full freedom to initiate the Guest Lectures of Businessmen / Industrialists as a visiting faculty/ guest faculty and all financial support is given for such activities.

Student Involvement

The students are made to involve in academic activities by selecting the class representatives for each division. These representatives are a liason between the student and class coordinator.

SIBER became Autonomous Institute under UGC Act in 1995, since then faculty members of SIBER have been shouldering administrative responsibilities with the same confidence and enthusiasm as their teaching and research activities. Under the able guidance of Dr. M. M Ali, Chairman, MBA Programme, all faculty members, with variety of abilities, qualifications and backgrounds are involved in some administrative work.

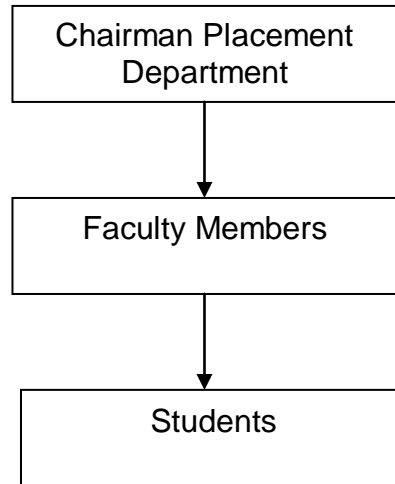

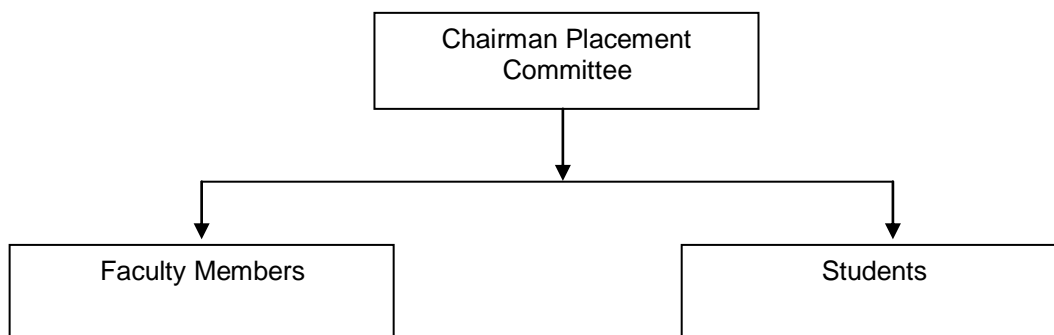
